Ms. Eart Sokphorn is 38 years old who lives in Samaki village, Snam Pras commune, Bakan district, Pursat province. Her family has 05 members, 3 daughters. Her husband is a worker in the village and she is a housekeeper in the family and helps her husband make money and take



care of their children. they can earn little money to support their hold family include eating, drinking water, study materials, hospital service, etc.

FLD organization always observed to their diet and water consumption is not correct and not hygiene well. Before, they used well water or rainwater for drinking and sometimes they drank directly and sometimes boiling water, so that's why they got many health problems such as

sick, diarrhea, malnutrition, nausea, headache. etc. this's the main case that makes their families waste time, money and all children cannot study well. By the way, she really did not

have much money to bought water filler for drinking.

In fact, FLD has conducted sanitation, latrine, water filter, water reservoir, and hygiene projects and FLD's staff has announced those projects to all the target villages. And she participated with FLD based on Pursat province in the various meetings which were organized by the project as hands washing, hygiene, sanitation. After she had joined with training courses, she understood how it's important to drink clean water. Because Ms. Sokphorn has little money for contribution, so she decided to



request a water filter. After she got a water filter on 10 December 2020, she going to use it every day and clean it when it has any problems. One more, she told FLD's staff that she going



to have time to works and her daughters can go to study and especially we have good health.

FLD collaborated with RCA's financial to conducted on the greater community in 5 target villages and all the budget got from ACR to support water filter project. Ms. Sokphorn represents the Samaki community very thankful and appreciates to FLD organization and ACR Australia for helping our community.
